**From 8AM – 2PM or until 200 numbers have been distributed\***

*\*Applicants will be given a number upon arrival. Only 200 numbers will be distributed per Fuel Fund Day.*

Income qualified FirstEnergy customers may be eligible to receive a grant of up to the amount of their delinquent balance, not to exceed \$300.

**WE CANNOT HELP CUSTOMERS WITH CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS UTILITIES.**

Accounts that have been **SHUT OFF**, or Accounts with a **DISCONNECT NOTICE** must be paid down to \$300 or less in order to receive assistance. Applicants also must have made a good faith payment on their account within the 90 days before the date of application for Fuel Fund Assistance.

**Eligibility is based on household income at or below 200% of the Federal poverty level, as per below:**

**Persons applying for Ohio Fuel Fund Assistance must provide the following:**

- ① Photo Identification - Driver's License or Photo I.D.**
- ② Social Security Card - or legal document with full Social Security Number**
- ③ Most recent delinquent electric bill or shut-off notice**
- ④ Proof of gross monthly income for ALL individuals residing in the home for the last 30 days before application for assistance**
- ⑤ Proof of a good faith payment made within the past 90 days**

**If you do not have all of the items listed above, we will not be able to assist you.**

We cannot make any payments on a deferred or finaled account balance. The person whose name appears on the Ohio Edison bill must be the person who applies for assistance **UNLESS** the account holder sends in a letter, dated no more than 7 days before the Fuel Fund application, that gives permission for a second party to apply for assistance on his or her behalf **AND** the most recent delinquent electric bill, and a copy of the account-holder's photo I.D. and Social Security Card.
